Attorney's Fee Cases

Eligibility:

1. You have a family law case in Marion County. (Child support enforcement cases are not eligible.)
2. You are unable to afford an attorney, and you meet the income eligibility guidelines.
3. Your spouse or the other parent makes a great deal more money than you do.

This program will attempt to obtain attorney's fees for you so that you will be able to hire your own attorney. You will be provided free legal assistance in filling out all necessary paperwork to obtain a Hearing on Attorney's Fees.

You will have an attorney with you at the hearing, and if the Court orders the other party to pay for your attorney's fees, then you will be able to hire an attorney of your choice to represent you. You may also be able to hire your attorney at a reduced fee through Heartland's Modest Means Program.

Hearings are held on the 4th Wednesday of the month at 4:30 p.m.

How do I apply?

You must go through intake by calling Heartland Pro Bono Council at 317-614-5304. At that time, a determination will be made if you are eligible for this program.
